SDCA Members & Partners

Free of charge. All current SDCA members and official partners are invited to attend at no cost, recognising their ongoing commitment to the association and the Swiss data centre industry.

Non-members & Non-partners

Participation fee applies. Interested parties outside the SDCA community may attend upon payment of a participation fee of CHF 200.-, subject to availability and approval.

Invitation Management

Invitation-only format. All invitations are managed centrally by SDCA, ensuring appropriate attendee mix and adherence to capacity constraints.

Venue Selection & Booking

Identify and secure a suitable restaurant with capacity for approximately 40 guests. Priority locations include central Zurich or the Zurich Airport area, with venues serving as excellent reference points for ambience and service quality.

Early Communication

Distribute **Save-the-Date invitations** well in advance to maximise attendance from key stakeholders. Early notification allows busy professionals to reserve the date and prioritise attendance at this exclusive networking opportunity.

Restaurant Coordination

Maintain close communication with the selected venue to ensure seamless execution. Flexibility is essential—participant numbers may require adjustment as RSVPs are confirmed, and the restaurant must be prepared to accommodate reasonable variations.

Draw inspiration from the proven **Swiss Council** format, which has demonstrated consistent success in fostering high-quality professional connections within similar industry contexts.

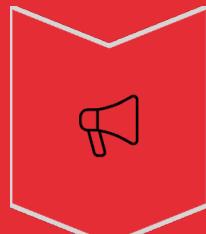

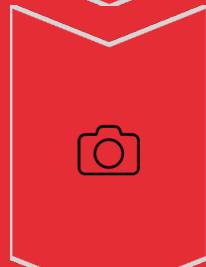
Official Announcement

Concept Confirmation

Finalise the Tavolata concept details and sponsorship model with key stakeholders, ensuring alignment on objectives, format, and expected outcomes.



Venue Selection

Identify, evaluate, and book the ideal restaurant venue, prioritising locations that balance accessibility, ambience, and capacity requirements.



Sponsor Recruitment

Secure commitment from two SDCA members or partners to serve as event co-sponsors, clarifying benefits and cost-sharing arrangements.



Materials Preparation

Design and prepare Save-the-Date communications, formal invitations, and all supporting event materials in line with SDCA branding guidelines.



Public Launch

Publish the official event announcement on sdca.ch and initiate the invitation distribution process to the SDCA community.
